Please indicate the candidate's relevant skills and experience with examples.

1. Finance/Budgeting

As a Chief Officer and Head of Service with over 36 years of experience, he has executive responsibility for corporate, departmental and divisional revenue budgets of around £4.4m annually as well as ongoing capital budgets varying between £1m and £2m annually. As Chair of the Business Gateway Scotland Board he has responsibility for overseeing an operational budget of around £12m per annum.

2. HR/Personnel

He has executive responsibility for around 110 staff as well as indirect responsibility for staffing in various other remits at national and local levels e.g. Business Gateway National Board

3. Chairing/Leading Meetings

In his professional and private life (within the community), he has been responsible for chairing committees, directorships and multi-disciplinary teams at every stage. For example as current Chair of the Angus Economic Development Partnership, Chair of the Business Gateway Scotland Board and past Chair of the Scottish Local Authority Economic Development Group (SLAED). Also as past President of Forfar Rotary Club and former Chair of the Forfar Academy School Board.

4. Sales/Marketing

His primary role in economic development is about marketing and promotion of Angus and Angus based companies locally, nationally and internationally for investment and tourism. He is responsible for a marketing team of nine covering a wide range of electronic marketing, websites, as well as specific promotions for golf and other key sectoral activities. This was recognised in 2008 when he was awarded the "Angus Ambassador of the Year".

5. Public Policy

As a Chief officer within Local government he is well versed in Public policy and governance.

6. Event Planning

During his career he has been involved in planning and overseeing a number of major events (e.g. the annual International Tartan Day, "Angus Walking festival" and other festival and events e.g. the introduction of the annual Seafest in Arbroath). He also has responsibility for planning the infrastructural requirements for major events planned by other parties e.g. as Chair of the All Agency Committee (Council, Police, Emergency Services etc..) for the British Open, Seniors and Ricoh Womens' British Open golf events at Carnoustie.

7. International Business

He also has been responsible for leading the council's support for international trade activities by supporting companies in their internationalisation and has led trade missions and sectoral participation at conferences and exhibitions around the world over the last 30 years. For example oil and gas companies at Houston, Singapore, Stavanger. As lead offer for the council's Angus in China Initiative he has developed extensive business networks in China especially in the golf tourism sector. He was the keynote at two recent golf symposiums at Tianjin (October 2010) and in Dalian (July 2011). He was made an honorary citizen of Yantai in Shandong Province in 2008.

8. Other Relevant Skills/Experience

He is a member of the Royal Town Planning Institute; the Institution of Economic Development and the Society of Local Authority Chief Executives (SOLACE). He is a former Chair of the Scottish Local Authority Economic Development Group (SLAED) and is a special adviser on tourism to the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities (Cosla). He is currently Chair of the Business Gateway Scotland Board.

He is a Director on the board of the Carnoustie Golf Links Management Committee company Ltd and the Monifieth Golf Links Co Ltd. He is an alternate Director of the Montrose Golf Links Co Ltd
