





#### **Skills & training**

Housed in a 3,000m<sup>2</sup> workshop, the MSIP Skills Academy will cater for **250 learners** per year.

Initially, the **curriculum** will cover new skills (AI, AR, digital, VR) as well as technical training in manufacturing and low carbon transport and will be heavily influenced by industry needs.

**Bespoke** packages will be offered on, for example, wind turbine servicing, battery manufacture, HFC assembly...

Dedicated **STEM engagement** area to educate, inspire and attract young learners.
